In a 4-day private sailing journey with our licensed captain, we will travel to three of the most beautiful Sporades islands: Skiathos, Skopelos and Alonnisos. This ultimate island-hopping journey will certainly be one of your favorite experiences in Greece!

The sailing route is usually identified before departure because it depends on the weather. Once we hit the sea, we sail towards the first island while stopping at nearby uninhabited islets to go swimming. During the evening, the captain parks the boat at the port & we have the entire evening to enjoy the island at our discretion. We sleep on board and the next day follows the same plan, but on a different island. It is the perfect experience to take in all of what Greece has to offer: culture, nature, sea, entertainment, food and much more!

Here are a few words about each island:

## Skiathos:



Skiathos has the hippest night life out of all the Sporades islands. Popular amongst younger adults, it's an island that combines both night life and peace and quiet.

## Skopelos:

Skopelos is recognized as the greenest island in Greece. Half of the island is covered with virgin pine forest. Popular amongst couples & families, it is famously known for its crystal waters & greenery. The Hollywood movie 'Mamma Mia' was filmed in Skopelos, & ever since then it has gained tremendous popularity. Particularly the impressive church of Agios Ioannis Kastri, which is known as the Mamma Mia Church!



## Alonnisos:



Alonnisos is an island ideal for those who want to unwind and enjoy leisurely walks surrounded by pine forests, olive groves, and orchards. The island is the most remote of the Northern Sporades island group, and plays host to the National Marine Park of Northern Sporades, a refuge for rare seabirds, dolphins and the Mediterranean monk seal. The beaches are crystal clear and surrounded by lush greenery, creating a relaxing atmosphere.
