Spring Intern:

We make wine from grapes that our students plant and harvest in our very own campus vineyard. In Spring students cultivate, fertilize, plant, and tend the grapes. Alongside farm supervisors, interns participate in all these tasks, giving them a better appreciation of each sip of wine they take. Interns also prune olive trees and work with seedling corn, soya beans, and rice. Come to Greece, work on the farm and drive the tractor, and learn what it takes to produce the foods and drinks consumed of the real Mediterranean diet.

Summer Intern:

Water is becoming an ever more valuable resource, and it is important for agriculture to adjust to water shortages by managing the water supply available. Work on our farm and learn first-hand about irrigation and crop management. What is grown relates to the amount of water available, making agriculture a field focused on evolving with the planet, not fighting it. During their internship, interns also prune olive trees, harvest wheat, barley, and a wide variety of vegetables, all the while learning and complying with ISO regulations.
